2017 FREE WEBINAR SERIES: Next Webinar July 25

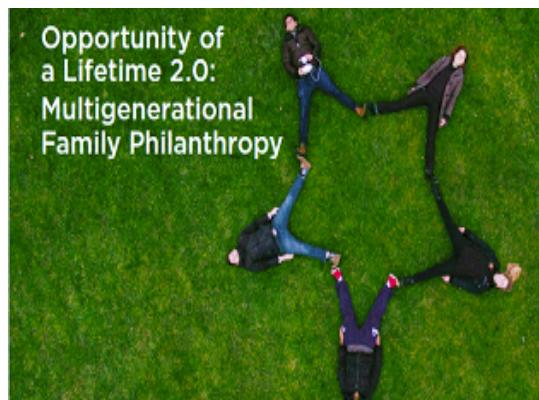
